

Age Eligibility:

Please refer to 'Age Level' on page 1 for correct age group.

Supervision:

Players must be accompanied by an adult throughout the duration of the tournament.

Matches:

All matches will be Singles in a Round Robin format and the format will be decided by the Tournament Director, determined by the number of entries and courts available.

Events:

1. Players may enter one event only – RED, ORANGE or GREEN.
2. **GREEN** – will play on full sized court and will score in a normal set format.
3. **ORANGE** – will play on a ¾ sized court and will score in the best of 1 match tie break format (first to 10 with a 2 point advantage)
4. **RED** – will play on a ¼ sized court and will score best of 1 normal tie break (first to 7 with a 2 point advantage)

Event Schedule:

10:00am Sign in for ALL players

10:15am Play starts for all RED, ORANGE, GREEN events.

11:30am Presentation/Drinks

Player Ability:

1. **GREEN** – players should be able to serve, have knowledge of rules, and be able to score their own matches.
2. **ORANGE** – players should be able to serve (either over or underarm – drop serve) and score. Players should have knowledge of rules, requiring minimal assistance from parents / guardians.
3. **RED** – players should be able to serve underarm (drop serve) and be learning the rules of tennis (parents / guardians may be asked to assist in scoring and rules at tournaments)

ITN – INTERNATIONAL TENNIS NUMBER – By participating in this event you will be awarded an ITN which will give you a measure of your performance and a benchmark to improve on. For more information about the ITN system, please see www.oncourassessment.com
